Initial Inclusive Support

(IIS) - This is a service for families of a child or young person with a disability who are experiencing barriers in participating in leisure opportunities.

Partners in Play can assist by offering positive support, advice and guidance to the family and the service provider to promote the child's inclusion.

Where it is considered that short term inclusion support would help develop new opportunities for the child, families may contact us directly and professionals (with the consent of the child and family) may refer to us.
